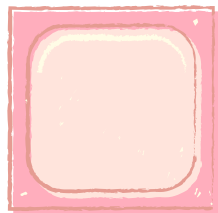

You may be eligible if you:

- are sexually active
- are at least 18 years of age
- have normal, regular menstrual cycles
- do not wish to become pregnant for at least 12 months
- are willing to try an investigational hormonal method of birth control

To take part in the study you must be willing and able to:

- use the study patch as your only method of birth control
- apply the patch at home and undertake home pregnancy tests
- complete an electronic diary regarding your menstrual cycle and sexual activity
- attend regular scheduled visits at UPMC Magee-Womens Hospital
